JUNE 2010

A Poster Workshop was conducted for the students of the theatre wing. The resource person was Mr. Umesh and 30 students participated in the workshop which lasted for two and half weeks. The outcome was an exhibition of 50 posters by the students on various themes like environment, women issues and water conservation.
